OFFICIAL MUD VOLLEYBALL RULES

1. All Tournament Director's decisions are final. No protests are allowed.
2. Maximum of six players on the court at one time during a game. Two of the players must be female and on the court at all times. Can play with five players but two must be female. If necessary, it is possible to play with four players, but one must be female. Team rosters limited to ten players.
3. Players may only play on one team throughout the tournament. The Tournament Director in the event of injuries, etc., may make exceptions. All players must sign a wavier before playing!
4. Shoes are mandatory! It is recommended that shoes be duct taped to ensure they stay on in the mud.
5. The tournament will consist of round-robin pool play followed by a single elimination tournament. All games will use rally scoring.
6. "Ball On" will only be called if the ball interferes with play, (directly or indirectly), or if the ball becomes a safety hazard.
7. Teams will provide a referee and scorekeeper for each match as assigned by the Tournament Director. The scorekeeper is responsible for getting the score sheet before the match starts. The WINNING TEAM is responsible for bringing the score sheet to the registration tent.
8. Blocking or attacking a serve is not allowed. First violation by a team in a game will be a warning resulting in a replay. Subsequent violations will result in a point being awarded to the serving team.
9. All substitutions must be made into the serving position. Substitutes will leave the game from the front right position. Substitutes will enter into the back right position just prior to serving. All players do NOT have to substitute OUT, and players may substitute back IN, in any order, provided that Rule #2 is maintained.
10. Players will rotate in a clock-wise direction before each serve, including after the first sideout in a game.
11. Players must keep proper relative position before each serve.
12. Only front row players may attack or block the ball when it is above the height of the net.
13. All net violations will be called. Hair touching the net is not a violation. Clothing touching the net is a violation.
14. All Jewelry (watches, necklaces, bracelets, etc.) should be removed.
15. If the ball hits mud before hitting solid ground, it's "IN."

16. If the ball hits a pole or its support cables, it is "OUT." "Let Serves" are NOT allowed. If the ball hits the net or the net cables on a serve, it is "OUT." On a return of serve and thereafter, if the ball hits the net or the net cables it is still "IN PLAY."
17. Any method may be used to serve the ball, as long as the ball is obviously hit and not thrown.
18. Serves will be made from the back right with server standing in mud. If, in the referee's judgement the server is too far out of position, the serve will be replayed.
19. Players may not enter another court during, before, or after an attempt to play the ball. Players can play, but not attack, serve or spike the ball from outside the court.
20. The score keeper should call out the score before each serve. The referee will motion for serve. The score keeper should assist the referee in looking for net violations and other faults.
21. Players may not reach across the net to attack a ball. Players may reach across the net to block a ball, provided that attacking team does not have a play on the ball or has used their allowed three team hits.
22. Each team is allowed two 30 second timeouts per a game.
23. Maximum of three team hits per side. A female does NOT have to touch the ball. A block does NOT count as a hit.
24. The ball may be played by any part of the body, as long as it is not held or thrown. Obvious carries or lifts should be called. Double hits are allowed on any first ball over the net that does not involve finger action, as long as the double hit occurs during one attempt to play the ball.
25. Incidental contact under the net is not a fault. Players may cross under the net as long as they do not interfere with players on the opposing team. The opposing player does not have to be making a play on the ball for there to be interference.
26. Receive of serve is handled in the same manner as any first ball over the net. (See Rule 24). Overhead/open hand serve receive is allowed.

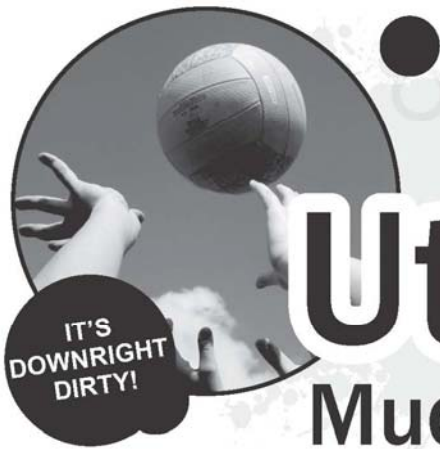
2010 PARTICIPANT WAIVER/RELEASE and TEAM ROSTER

THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE YOU COME

You Need To Bring:

1. Duct tape—useful for keeping shoes and other articles of clothing attached.
2. Towels for drying off
3. Clothes for wearing home (you will not want your playing clothes in your car)
4. “Trashable” clothes for playing in the mud.
5. Protective eyewear
6. Plenty of sunscreen
7. A tent or some kind of shelter for your team to use between games and chairs to sit in.

Other Stuff:

1. Leave Fido at home—no dogs allowed.
2. No alcohol on the premises—there will be cooler checks.
3. No re-entry to the playing venue. Bring everything you need on your first trip.
4. No glass containers of any kind—there will be cooler checks.
5. No grills and no open fires
6. Clean up your area when you leave
7. Each team is required to provide referees for games during the day. Your referee schedule will be provided. Failing to do so will remove one win and add one loss to a team’s score.
