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WHY SHOULD YOU INVEST IN THE Boys & Girls Club?

IMPORTANT FACTS:

- * The Boys & Girls Club of Moorpark serves nearly 2,000 kids annually.
- * We serve 320 kids daily at our five locations in Moorpark.
- * There is one staff person for every 15 kids served.
- * 54 % of the youth we serve daily are from low-income families.
- * Membership is only \$20 a year so any child can afford to belong; however, no child is ever turned away because of inability to pay.
- * Because membership fees are only about 1% of our budget, the services we provide are only made possible through the tremendous support we receive from individuals, organizations, and corporations such as yours.

RETURN ON INVESTMENT

According to the Harris Survey of Boys & Girls Club Alumni, some remarkable data came out that points to a serious return on investment in Boys & Girls Clubs across America including:

- * 57% of Alumni said the Club actually saved their life.
- * 45% of Alumni said that the Club helped them graduate from high school.
- * 77% of Alumni said they learned good leadership skills at the Club.
- * Across the board, 28% indicated they would have dropped out of school without the benefit and support of their Boys & Girls Club.

According to a 2010 independent study of Boys & Girls Clubs right here in Ventura County:

- * 85% of parents say their child's school performance has improved since attending the Club.
- * 92% of parents agree that their children have become more confident in themselves since attending the Club.
- * 97% of parents feel their children are in a safe environment while at the Club.
- * 83% of parents agree their children have shown more interest in regular physical exercise since attending the Club.

Bottom line, the study revealed that for every **\$1** invested in our Boys & Girls Club, **\$11.72** is reinvested in the community. That's a nearly **1200%** return for every dollar invested.
