In Rebekah’s creation the horse and rider are at the top of the hurdle where they successfully join as a team to create the piece, “Stand Up and Jump: Turning Obstacles into Opportunities”. Rebekah, born in Zhanjiang, China began her love of drawing around the age of 5, and her passion for drawing horses around the age of 7. She received the Pablo Picasso Art Award in 5th grade, as well as the

Principal’s Award for Academic Excellence in 6th and 7th grade at Sequoia Middle School. Rebekah also loves music and enjoys playing the flute and the acoustic guitar.



John Wullbrandt

John Wullbrandt is a California-based painter, born in Santa Barbara. He has spent 30 years travelling the world and painting. John is best known for his realistic work and allegorical images. His most recent exhibition, “Celebrating California”, was hosted by the Art Gallery at the Four Seasons Hotel Westlake Village where in addition his murals in the hotel include: the Grand Stairs, Hampton’s, and the

Spa Foyer. For 20 years, much of John’s work was collected by his longtime mentor and patron, David Murdock. In this letter we would like to highlight a few things that we have done with the funding received from the Gala and other fundraisers over the past year.

We now have gone from serving 1200 kids last year to serving over 1850 this year. **WOW!** While businesses have been downsizing we have substantially increased our members. 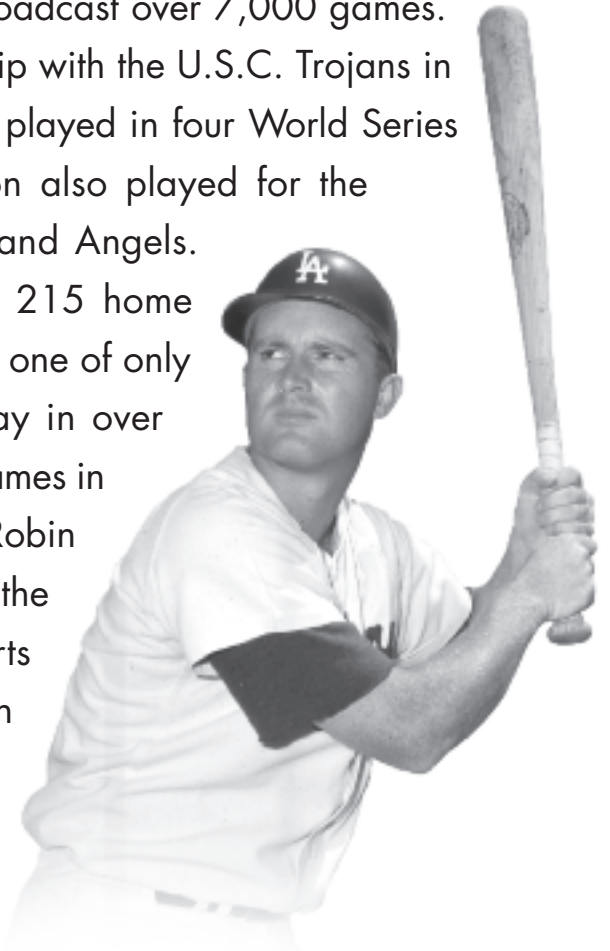

Ron Fairly has been a fixture in the Southern California baseball community, having spent 48 years in the Major Leagues as a player and broadcaster. From 1958 to 2006, Ron either played or broadcast over 7,000 games. After winning the National Championship with the U.S.C. Trojans in 1958, he signed with the Dodgers and played in four World Series in 1959, 1963, 1965 and 1966. Ron also played for the Expos, Cardinals, Athletics, Blue Jays and Angels. Fairly's career ended successfully with 215 home runs and 1,044 runs batted in. Fairly is one of only three players in baseball history to play in over 1,000 games in the infield and 1,000 games in the outfield (others are Stan Musial and Robin Yount). In 1997, Ron was inducted into the University of Southern California Sports "Hall of Fame." Ron resides in Indian Wells and is the CEO of his L.E.D. lighting company.

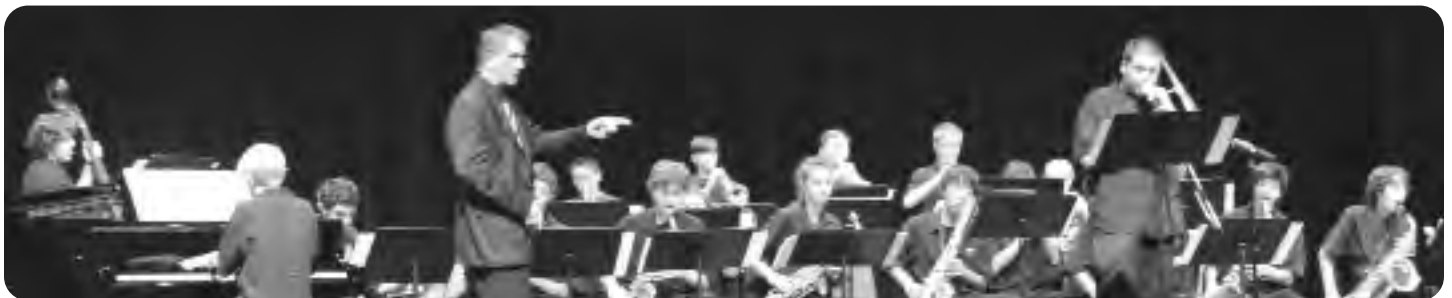

Mr. McKagan has been recognized for his outstanding efforts in the field of education by receiving the Agoura Hills Chamber of Commerce's "Outstanding Educator" Award, the Mr. Holland's Opus Award, the Los Angeles Music Center's BRAVO Award, and the Amgen Award for Teacher Excellence.

The Lindero Canyon Middle School "A" Jazz Band, under the direction of Mr. McKagan, is a jazz band modeled after the great "big bands" of the 1930's and 40's, including Count Basie, Stan Kenton and Duke Ellington. The students in the band are in the eighth grade and most are 13 years old. All of the students take private music lessons and are very enthusiastic about their music and proud of their musical accomplishments. The jazz band performs at over 25 concerts each year, and is a fine example of the many wonderful students that attend Lindero Canyon Middle School, in Agoura Hills, CA.

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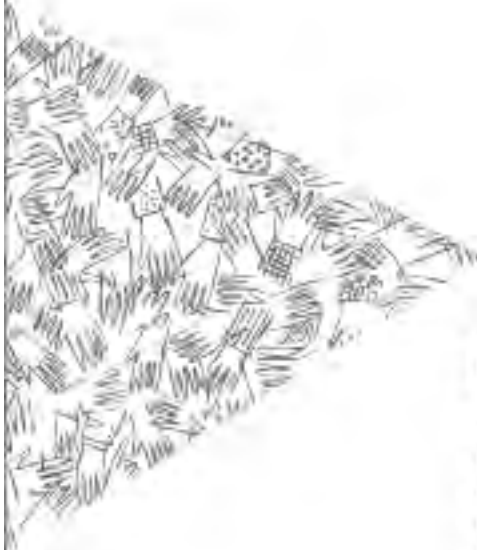

“Emma” sat, head in hands, wondering why and how others made such bad, life-altering choices. An older sister pregnant at 16. A young neighbor agonizing over whether or not “to party.” Reflecting, she sighed with relief and pride, facing her big decision: which college to attend. “Emma” was a typical Boys & Girls Club member who found herself and her potential.

The Boys & Girls Clubs in Ventura County offer kids positive choices and empower them to live up to their greatest potential. As kids spend time at the Clubs learning and having fun, their parents can work, confident that their kids are in a safe place. This positive ripple effect significantly impacts our local economy.

It All Adds Up

For every dollar invested in the Boys & Girls Clubs in Ventura County, \$8 is reinvested in the community.

One Small Choice Can Make A Big Economic Impact

Nearly 23,000 kids throughout Ventura County attend a Boys & Girls Club. Working parents choose the Clubs because they’re safe, nurturing and provide cost-effective care for their kids. Club members choose engaging, enriching activities that improve grades and build meaningful relationships with peers and adults.

A recent study found that being involved with a Boys & Girls Club teaches kids about positive choices and creates an incredible economic ripple effect for the community. The study* was authored by Dr. Jamshid Damooei, co-director of the Center for Leadership and Values at California Lutheran University and chair of the department of

Opening A Paycheck Instead Of A Final Notice

The Boys & Girls Clubs in Ventura County not only provide outstanding programs for youth, they provide quality, safe child care so parents can work.

97% of parents agree their kids are safe at the Club.

38% of parents credit the Club for helping them focus at work, knowing they have safe child care.

Parents who reported they were able to maintain their jobs because their children attend the Clubs bring an additional \$144,740,064 in earnings per year to their families.

Clutching A Diploma Instead Of A Beer

Education is a top priority at the Clubs. They support students academically and with programs that combat negative influences that detail students from graduating high school.

70% of Ventura County youth pass the high school exit exam.

97% of Club members pass the high school exit exam.

Based on data relating to educational attainment and average annual earnings, Club kids’ combined earnings per year will be \$106,586 more each year and \$3,045,306 more over their lifetime, compared to those who do not graduate from high school.



Holding A Basketball Instead Of A Baby

Through self-esteem and health classes, Club girls learn how to say no to teen pregnancy and yes to positive activities that build self-confidence.

Stealing Home Base Instead Of A Bicycle

The clubs are open during the peak juvenile crime hours of 3-7 p.m., giving kids the chance to choose healthy activities over crime.

9.1% of youth in Ventura County are arrested.

4.7% of youth at the Boys & Girls Clubs are arrested.

That saves \$21,384,000 in juvenile justice system costs each year.

Grabbing An Apple Instead Of A Candy Bar

With so many programs promoting physical activity, 6,542 kids lost weight this past year at the Boys & Girls Clubs in Ventura County.

64% of Club parents agree their children now make better food and drink choices.

83% of Club parents say their child is more interested in physical exercise.

A sustained 10% body mass index reduction lowers the lifetime medical costs by \$2,300 to \$5,300 for a man; \$2,200 to \$5,200 for a woman. (Age and initial BMI affect the range.) "Children treated for obesity are roughly three times more expensive for the health care system than children of normal weight," according to the William J. Clinton Foundation.

The Boys & Girls Clubs In Ventura County

The Boys & Girls Clubs in Ventura County work to inspire and enable all youth in the county to realize their full potential as productive, responsible and caring citizens. In Ventura County, seven Boys & Girls Clubs organizations operate a total of 46 sites, serving nearly 23,000 youth. Program areas offered to youth include character and leadership development, education and career development, health and life skills, the arts, technology, and sports, fitness and recreation.

The Clubs help develop youth into caring adults, which saves significant taxpayer dollars in the short- and long-term. In response, many community members choose to support the Clubs' efforts through financial contributions, a key source of revenue for the Clubs.
