

Boys & Girls Club of Gloucester - 2013 Flounder Tournament Regulations

***Revised 6/5/2013**

1. All entries must be in prior to 6:00 AM., Saturday, July 13th, 2013.
2. Fish must be caught by rod and reel only.
3. Only one (1) prize per entrant.
4. A representative from each registered boat is **required** to attend the Captain's Meeting on Friday, July 12th, 2013 starting at 6:30 PM located at Crown Pointe Marina, Hayes, VA. For directions to Crown Pointe Marina visit www.crownpointemarina.com.
5. Official tournament starting time is 6:00 AM. (lines in water) on Saturday, July 13th, 2013.
6. Fish can be brought in by car or boat but must be weighed by 5:00 PM that same day Saturday, July 13th (must be standing in line at designated weigh station). **Weigh station is located at Crown Pointe Marina, Hayes, VA and will be open at 3:00 p.m.** If deadline is not met fish will be disqualified. Each boat may weigh-in up to three (3) flounder only. Winners will be determined by the combined weight of the team's three (3) flounder. **All fish weighed to be held by Weigh Master until 30 minutes after last fish weighed. All fish will be tagged, numbered and kept in Weigh Master's cooler.*
7. In case of tie, earliest time of weigh-in will determine the winner.
8. Weigh Master's Decision is Final!
9. Any contestant found guilty of cheating, attempting to cheat, or otherwise deviating from the regulations of this tournament, shall be disqualified and considered ineligible for further and future participation.
10. If small craft advisories are posted at 5:00 AM the day of the tournament for the area from New Point to Cape Henry, the tournament will be postponed until the "blow day" of Sunday, July 14th, 2013. The small craft advisory information shall be as announced by NOAA and obtained from the weather channel on marine VHF radio. Any questions, you can call Chuck at 804-695-4830.
11. **If tournament is cancelled due to inclement weather on Sunday, July 14th, all festivities, including food/drink, raffles, Calcutta and drawing of entrants for 1st thru 10th places will be held on Sunday, July 14th at 3:00 p.m, Crown Pointe Marina. You must be present to win.**
12. There will be an optional big fish Calcutta with an entry fee of \$100 per boat. Monies will be distributed as follows: 1st place – 60% of total purse; 2nd place – 40% of total purse. You must tag your heaviest Calcutta fish with the special tag provided at registration on Friday, July 12th.
13. All participants agree that the Boys & Girls Club of Gloucester, Crown Pointe Marina and any sponsor of this tournament shall not be liable for injury, loss or damage of any kind resulting from participation in this tournament.
14. **Lady Angler Division** – The largest fish wins prize. In case of a tie, the first fish brought in will win. Fish may also be entered in main event.
15. **Kid Angler Division** – children 12 years old and under may participate. The largest fish wins prize. In case of a tie, the first fish brought in will win. Fish may also be entered in main event.
Note: Any complaints or rules violations should be reported to the tournament committee prior to finalization of weigh in.
