The Dinner Auction Committee, led by our energetic Dinner Auction Co-Chairs Christopher Papile and Veronica Weymouth, has done an extraordinary job of organizing a fun-filled evening for you tonight, and we are truly grateful for the time they have devoted to this event.

Teens that complete the Workforce Development Center program are eligible to earn entry-level jobs at the Thrift Stores and gain valuable retail experience. Our organization benefits because all Thrift Store revenue is recycled back into Club programs. The community benefits by being able to recycle items they no longer use, and give them life with someone else!

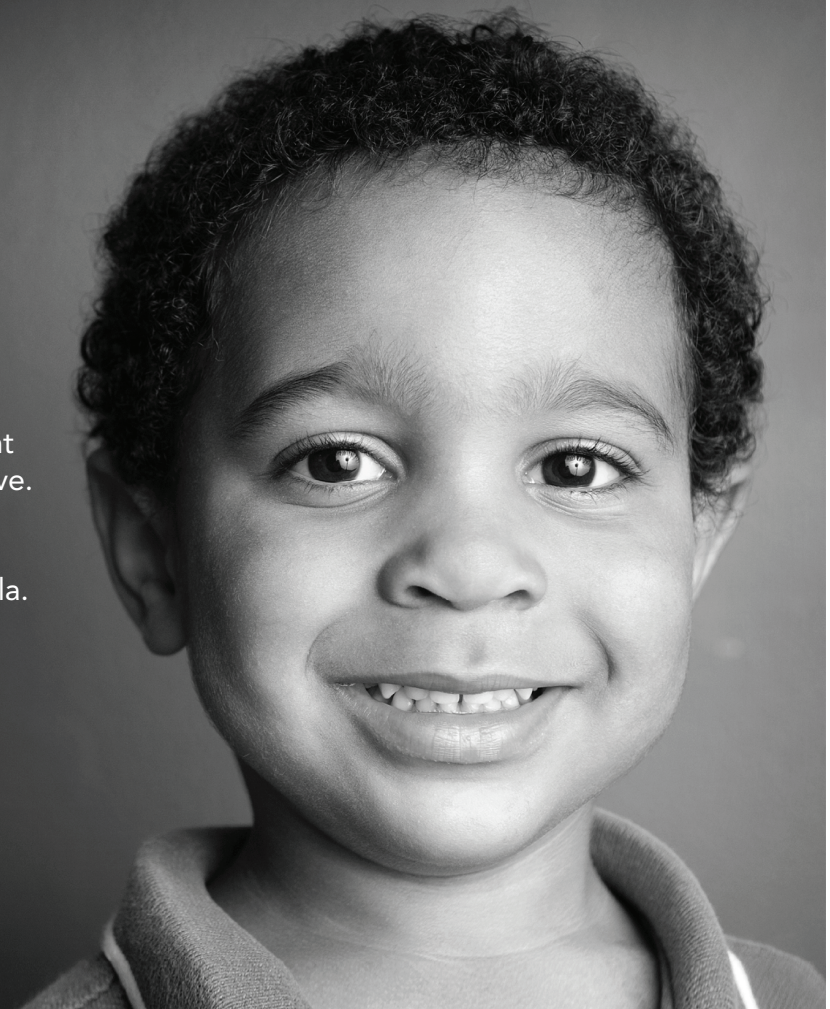

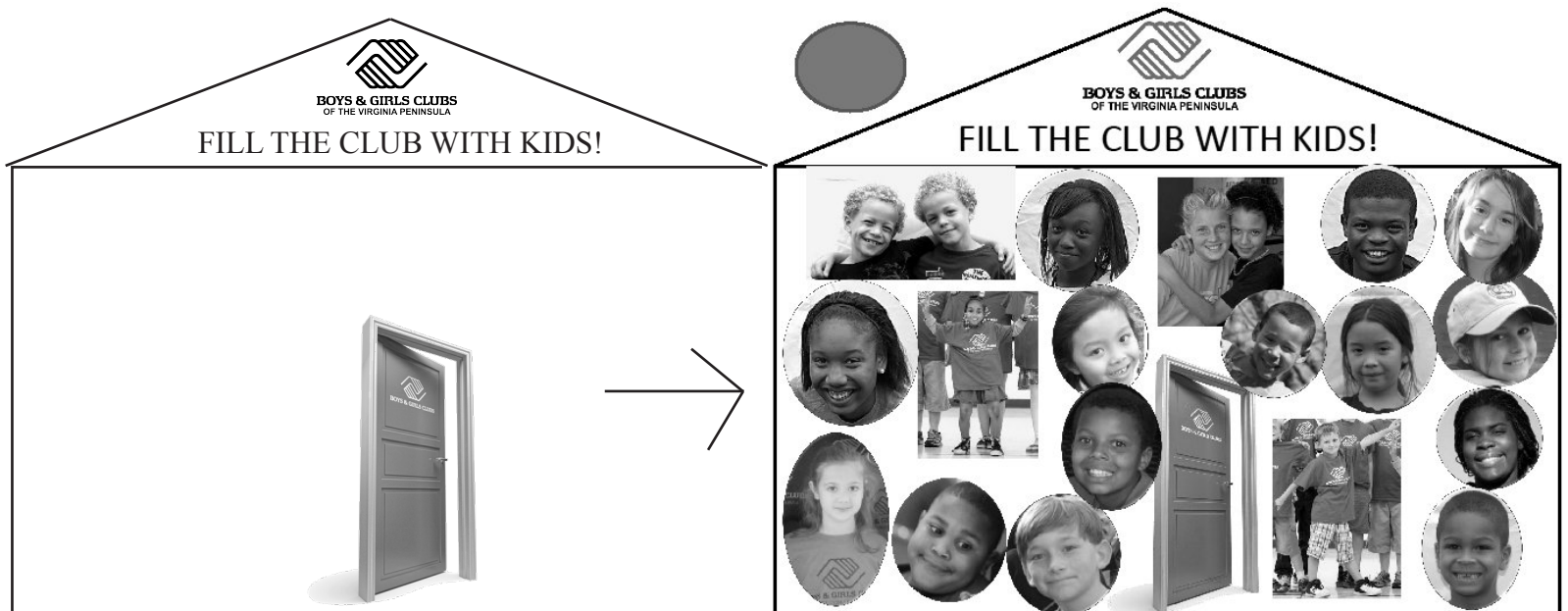

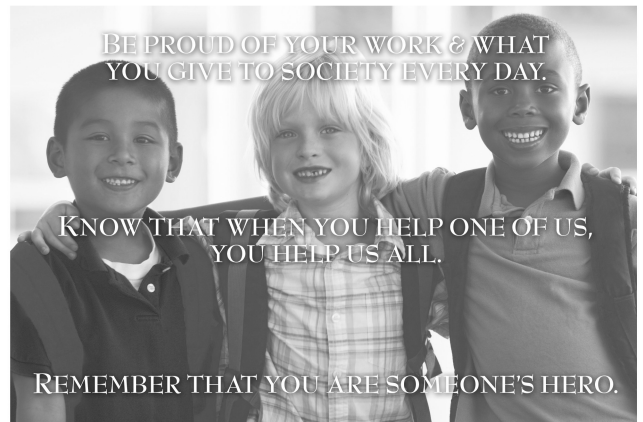
