## 2011 WILLIE MAC BASKETBALL SOPHOMORE TOURNAMENT RULES BOYS & GIRLS

South Dakota Interscholastic Basketball Rules will govern all play with the exception of these special rules.

- All Willie Mac Hoops tournaments are **NO TOLERANCE** tournaments. Any harassment of the officials, coaches, players, etc. will result in ejection from the game and forfeiture of that game.
- 5 minute warm-up will be allotted before each game (more if time permits)
- Women's sized basketball will be used for girls, men's sized basketball for boys.
- Teams will bring their own balls for warm-ups and the referee will select a ball from participating teams to use as the game ball
- All games will have 15-minute halves. Clock stops in all games.
- When pool play is used, 1<sup>st</sup> place, 2<sup>nd</sup> place and 3<sup>rd</sup> place will be determined by overall win-loss record. In case of a tie, tiebreakers will be: head to head record, points allowed, points differential and coin flip.
- 3-point shots will be scored in gyms with the arc on the floor.
- Full court defenses are allowed to a 12 -point lead.
- Technical fouls will result in 2 points and the ball. Players and coaches will be asked to leave the premises after the 2<sup>nd</sup> technical foul.
- Players will not talk to officials.
- 1<sup>st</sup> overtime is 3 minutes, 2<sup>nd</sup> overtime is sudden victory (1<sup>st</sup> team to score wins).
- Three timeouts per game (each team receives additional timeout for overtime).
- 1 and 1 bonus will be shot on the 7<sup>th</sup> team foul at 10<sup>th</sup> foul double bonus.
- After the 1<sup>st</sup> jumpball, possession will alternate.
- Proper sportsmanship is expected from all players, coaches and fans.

**Coaches**: You are responsible for your team. Any damage caused by your team will be billed to you as the responsible coach. Any player, coaches or fans acting in an unsportsmanlike manner will be asked to leave the site.
