You can then take the receipt to a staff/volunteer to receive your items. A final receipt will be mailed to you.

If you are not participating in Express Pay, a payment must be made in full the night of the auction for all items purchased during the evening. Payments may be made in cash, check or credit card.

Please present your auction receipt to a staff member/volunteer and they will locate your item.

### **Silent Auction Rules**

All Silent Auctions will begin at 5:00pm.

The Silent Auctions close at different times. Please listen to our MC and Auctioneer for details. There will be several announcements made in order to provide you the maximum amount of time to check your bids.

All items in the Silent Auction have bid sheets attached or affixed nearby. Please **WRITE YOUR BID NUMBER** next to the item that you desire.

Each Bid increment must be increased at least the predetermined amount listed on the bid sheets.

If you would like to assure yourself of obtaining an item, use the “guaranteed bid” amount at the bottom of the form. Items that receive the guaranteed bid are considered closed.

After making a bid, you must step back to allow free access for others to bid.
