Because it shouldn't hurt to be a child.

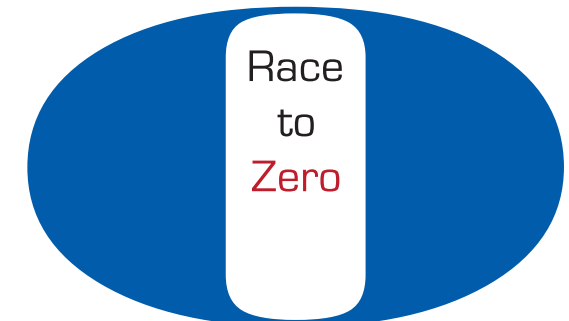

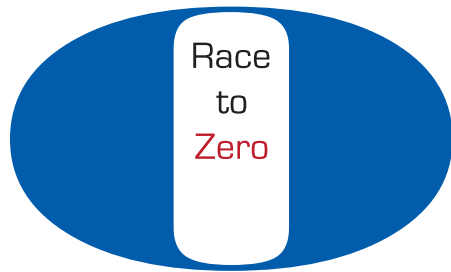
Join us for a fun, family friendly 5k ...
